Visit From Ultramarathon Runner Anthony Battah

On Saturday, July 29, the city of Sainte-Anne-de-Bellevue was pleased to welcome Montréal ultramarathon runner Anthony Battah as he embarked on the first day of the Ultra-Trail Monarque project.

The runner will follow the migratory path of the monarch butterfly, with the aim of drawing attention to the threat that hangs over this important pollinator, and more broadly, over our biodiversity.

As a "Monarch Friendly City" since 2017, Sainte-Anne-de-Bellevue was particularly proud to encourage Mr. Battah in his ambitious 4500 km journey.


Salsa by the Water
