February 23, 2023, deadline for making the first payment

SMOG WARNING

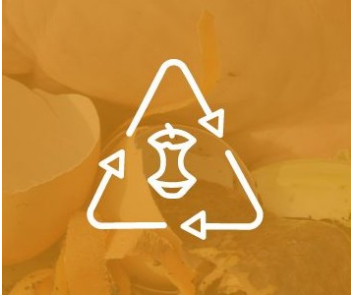
Rules concerning the use of solid fuel burning appliances and fireplaces

REMINDER: WINTER PARKING BY-LAW - NORTH SECTOR

Winter Parking By-law Amendment - North Sector

New this year - Amendment to Section 26 of By-law 769

Winter parking from 6:00 am to 1:00 am on streets **north** of the Félix-Leclerc Expressway (40), between December 1 and March 31 of each year, will be structured as follows:



a) On the even-numbered address side of the streets (always respecting the signage on site), parking will be permitted on Mondays, Wednesdays, Fridays and Sundays and prohibited on the other days of the week;

b) On the odd-numbered side of the street (always respecting the signage on site), parking shall be permitted on Tuesday, Thursday and Saturday and prohibited on other days of the week.
