SENIOR FRIENDLY MUNICIPALITY (MADA) CONSULTATION OF CITIZENS AGED OVER 65

Last spring, the City of Sainte-Anne-de-Bellevue surveyed its seniors as part of its MADA (Municipalité amie des aînés) program.

MADA aims to identify the needs of seniors and promote a culture of social inclusion regardless of age or ability, as well as encourage active aging among seniors.

In the second phase of consultation, the committee will contact citizens directly via focus groups or phone conversations.



The survey is open to anyone 65 years of age or older who lives in Sainte-Anne-de-Bellevue and has not participated in the previous survey.

The options are as follows:

- 1- Participate in a focus group via videoconference
- **2-** Be contacted by phone to discuss with committee members

All citizens are welcome to hold their own garage sales at their homes without the need for a permit, but **registration** is **required**. Registration opened on July 25.


This year, the City is pleased to offer the loan and delivery of tables.



WORKS IN PROGRESS

REM | Road closures on Chemin Sainte-Marie

In order to continue the construction work on the infrastructures dedicated to the REM, some obstructions will be necessary on a portion of Chemin Sainte-Marie.

Since July 11, and for a period of one and a half months, the eastbound lane of Chemin Sainte-Marie is completely closed to traffic.

The Ministère des Transports has started repair work on the Chemin des Pins overpass over Highway 40 in Sainte-Anne-de-Bellevue on August 8, 2022. The overpass is closed to all traffic for the duration of the work. Complete closures of Highway 40 are also expected in the evening, at night and on weekends.

BULKY WASTE COLLECTION

The next bulky waste collection will take place on Friday, **September 2**. It is important to remember that not everything can be included in this collection. Here is a list of what is accepted during this collection:

- Cabinets
- Bathtubs
- Desks
- Tables and chairs
- Dressers
- Bookcases
- Sinks
- Windows
- Large boxes
- Mirrors
- Rigid plastics and packaging
- Doors
- Toilets

Important:

Sofa and mattress



Upholstered objects must be taken to a collection point equipped to receive this type of waste (ecocenter) or to one of the two recovery companies in Montreal (Matt Canada or Recyc-matelas).
