Spring Cleaning : Special collection

The special collection will take place during the weeks of May 16 and 24.

Monday, May 16 to Friday, May 20, 2022:
NORTH Sector (north of Highway 40)

Tuesday, May 24 to Friday, May 27, 2022:
SOUTH Sector (south of Highway 40)

Place all your garbage (bulky items, electronics, construction materials, metal, etc.) at the curb before 7:00 a.m. on **the Monday morning of the start of collection in your area** and the Public Works Department will pick it up **free of charge**. Please note that the pick-up may take place over several days, but we will only be on your street once.

** We will not collect household hazardous waste (HHW)*

FREE COMPOST DISTRIBUTION

Free Compost Distribution

Each year we hold a free self-serve* compost distribution for the residents of Sainte-Anne-de-Bellevue, usually in May.

**Maximum quantity per residence: 120 liters (30 gallons) the equivalent of a full wheelbarrow!*

There will be 3 self-serve compost distribution points for the residents of Sainte-Anne-de-Bellevue:

- Pacifique Street (at the corner of Ste-Anne) - South End
- At the end of M.-C.-Bezner street - North end
- At the end of Leslie-Dowker street - North end

PROCEDURE FOR TENNIS COURT RESERVATION

NEW - Online tennis court reservation

With the warm weather back, it is now time to play outside. What better way to take advantage of this beautiful weather than to go to Crevier and Aumais parks to play tennis.

Online reservations

It is important to note that for the 2022 summer season, there will be a small change surrounding the practice of tennis on City courts. Residents wishing to play tennis will be required to reserve a court online for a maximum of 60 minutes. Reservations must be made through the [citizen portal](#). See the [available procedure](#) regarding the reservation. Only one hour of play is available each day per resident to allow everyone a chance to play. Please note, you can only reserve a court a maximum of three days in advance. For example: on Monday you will only be able to reserve a court for Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday. The minimum age to reserve a court is 12 years old.

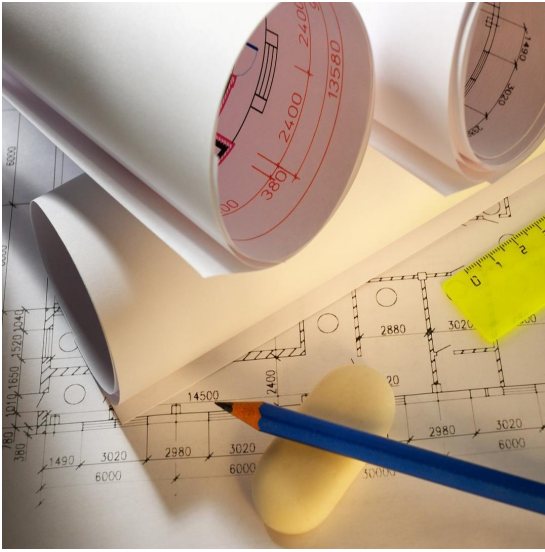
