# PDQ 1 activity report from the 1<sup>st</sup> of January to the 22<sup>nd</sup> of February for the city of Sainte-Anne-de-Bellevue.

Neighborhood police officers were extremely vigilant on the roads during the holiday season. A number of alcohol/drug control operations were successfully carried out in the area by officers from Neighborhood Station 1.

In addition, I'm pleased to report that no major traffic accidents have occurred since January 1 in the Neighborhood Station 1 area, in any of the 5 municipalities.

In addition to having been very present in the 5 municipalities of the sector during the holiday season, several road safety operations and several presences in vulnerable areas of the sector with the obstruction caused by the Ile aux Tourtes bridge were carried out by all personnel.

Finally, I am pleased to inform you that the secure exchange zone at Neighborhood Station 1 is now operational. This is a secure area where citizens can meet after an online transaction, under 24/7 surveillance. A sign clearly indicates the location of this zone, just a few feet from the entrance to the station. I sincerely hope you will take advantage of this preventive measure implemented with the help of our partner Info-Crime.

#### Road safety - Our traffic officers

- On January 22 and 23, 2 A-C and Demers operations for failure to comply with prohibited left-turn signs. During these operations, 18 statements of offence were issued.
- January 24, Garden city/Demers, operation for failure to obey the no-left-turn sign at this intersection. 4 statements of offence were issued.
- February 5, 20 and A-C, Operation for failure to obey the red light at morning rush hour. 8 statements of offence were issued.
- February 7 and 8, Ste-Élizabeth and Legault, Operation for failure to obey stop signs on St-Élizabeth. 9 statements of offence were issued. This issue comes up regularly at traffic committee meetings.
- February 8, 425 A-C, Operation speed on Anciens-combattants northbound. Several statements of offence issued during the operation.
- February 12, A-C and Pacifique, Operation speed on Anciens-combattants southbound. 8 statements of offence issued during the operation.

#### Bike patrols

- Throughout January and February, several patrols on the trails of Parc Nature l'Anse à l'Orme. A few notices given for off-leash dogs. Many citizens referred to Info-Coyote for coyote warnings.
- January 27: VPS presence in Robillard Park at a VPS fatbike initiation day organized by the city.
- February 7: Networking meeting at the arboretum.

## Socio-community agents

- November 21, Unveiling of the secure exchange zone at neighbourhood station 1. Following the unveiling, the news was published on the website of local newspaper The Suburban, as well as on the info crime Montréal website and social networks.
- On November 29 and December 7, Kiosque de prévention informed, educated and intervened as needed to prevent DV.
- December 13, presentation by part of the PDQ1 team to SAB citizens at Harpell Centre. Several issues discussed during the meeting.
- Several meetings planned at the Batshaw youth center in preparation for the "Beyond the badge" community outreach event.
- Several ad hoc meetings in schools to meet students with behavioural problems.
