Wildlife Series with Rob Baker

Conference | Wildlife at L'Anse-à-l'Orme

The presentation will feature the animals of the L'Anse-à-l'Orme area, which Rob Baker has been tracking in for over 15 years. He will present photos of the tracks and signs left behind as the animal moves across the landscape. White tailed deer, coyotes, deer mice, red fox, meadow voles, and mink, otter, and fishers are some of mammals inhabiting the L'Anse-à-l'Orme area.
