



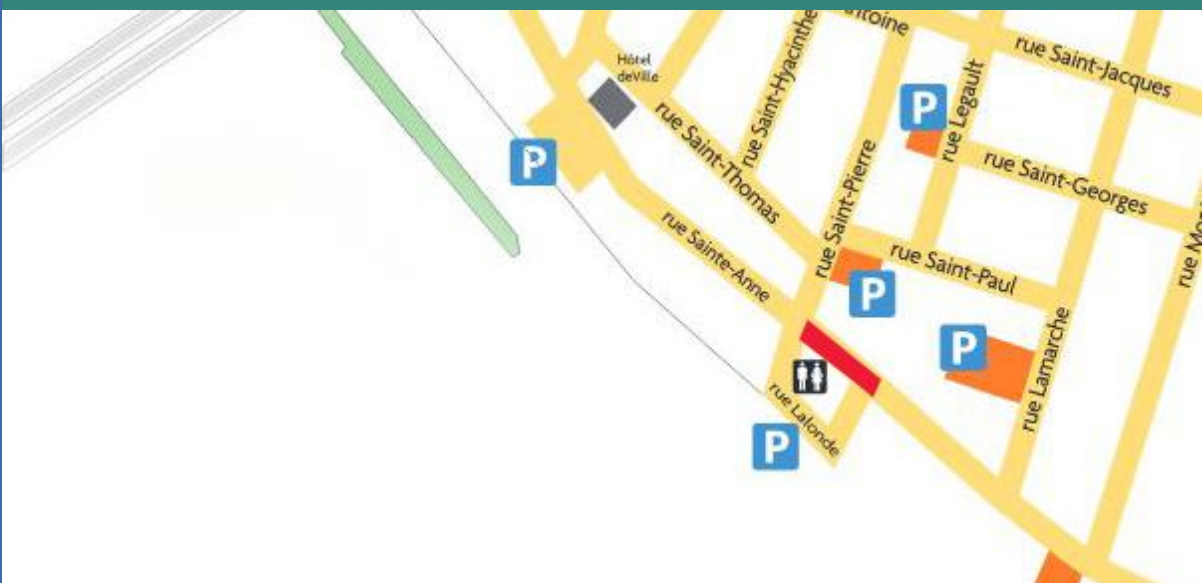
Garlic Festival: Partial Closure of Rue Ste-Anne

- your driver's license as proof of residence
- the registration certificate for your vehicle

- your driver's license
- the registration certificate for your vehicle
- a pay slip from the current month

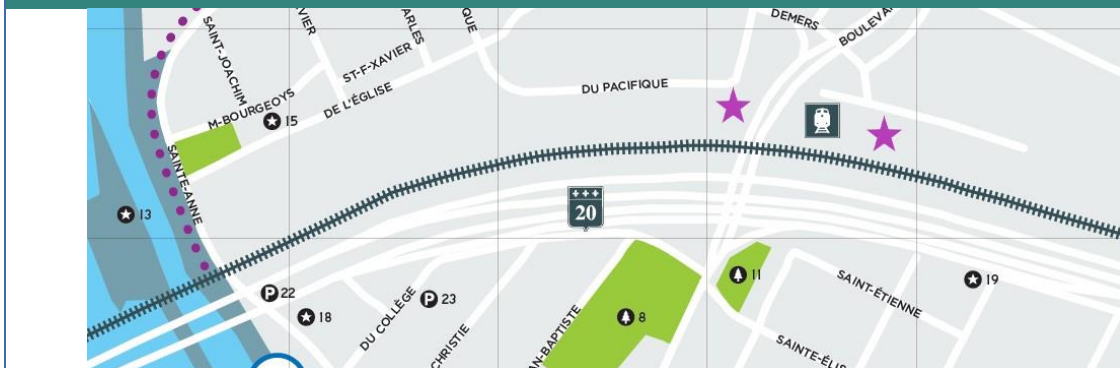
A Birth, A Tree
