Program Overview

The City of Sainte-Anne-de-Bellevue Street Performers Program offers a unique entertainment experience, bringing to life the boardwalk with exciting acts, live music, street performers during the summer months.

Sainte-Anne-de-Bellevue's Street Performers Program aims to encourage street performers and emerging artists with an opportunity to display their talents. As a cultural destination, the City's goal is to strengthen and expand the identity and presence of arts, culture, and entertainment offerings.

Benefits of the City of Sainte-Anne-de-Bellevue Street Performers Program

- Conveniently located on the Sainte-Anne-de-Bellevue boardwalk
- Artists are exposed to new audiences with high volume projection traffic
- Performers have the flexibility to manage their own time

Dates and Schedule

July 3 to September 6 inclusively

Thursdays: 5:00 pm to 8:00 pm – Rock, country, pop
Fridays: 5:00 pm to 8:00 pm - Rock, country, pop
Saturdays: 2:00 pm to 4:00 pm – Jazz, opera, choir, R & B (Boardwalk park only)
5:00 pm to 8:00 pm - Rock, country, pop
Sundays: 2:00 pm to 4:00 pm – Jazz, opera, choir, R & B

Eligibility

- Individual musicians
- Music groups
- Street performers
- Actors/theatre etc.

Artisans and people selling products or services are not permitted.

Program Requirements

A permit is required to participate in the Street Performers Program.

- Permits shall be valid from July 3 to September 6
- There is no cost to the permit
- Permits are not transferable and are date specific
- Street performers must comply with all applicable noise regulations
- Street performers must bring their valid permit and must show a copy of the permit to Municipal patrol agents if asked

Site

Stage at the Boardwalk Park

- Two (2) electrical plugs are at the artists disposal. No other material or supplies will be provided by the City.
- The stage is only accessible by foot. Any equipment must be transported by hand as vehicle circulation is not permitted on the boardwalk or in the adjacent park.
- The site must be maintained free of trash and debris within a ten-foot radius.
- Personal belongings or activities must not obstruct pedestrian traffic, entry and exit ways, or any public right-of-ways.

Stage at Lalonde Park

- Two (2) electrical plugs are at the artists disposal. No other material or supplies will be provided by the City.
- The site must be maintained free of trash and debris within a ten-foot radius.
- Personal belongings or activities must not obstruct pedestrian traffic, entry and exit ways, or any public right-of-ways.

Conduct

Street performers must conduct themselves in a safe, professional and respectable manner and abide by the Street Performers Program requirements. Street performers shall not:

- Solicit spectators and/or ask for contributions. A hat or other container may be placed on the ground for voluntary contributions.
- Consume any type of alcohol or drugs on stage or the boardwalk
- Use any type of weapon
- Create a fire hazard or use fire
- Display or offer food or drinks for sale
- Display or include any manner of lewdness in activities or performance nor should it aim to discriminate against any section of the public distinguished by colour, race, religion, national or ethnic origin, age, sex, sexual orientation, gender identify or expression of mental or physical disability.

The City holds the right to halt or suspend activities that disrupt normal business operations or jeopardize the safety of our neighbors and visitors.

Amplification

Sound levels are limited to a 65 decibel level; this limitation is for both amplified and non-amplified acts. These decibel limits may be changed at any time by the City and if ever a performer is requested by a City security or staff member to reduce their sound level, that request supersedes these sound level policies.
